GOLF COURSES ADVISORY BOARD

7 members, 3-year terms

Reference Sections 2-172 through 2-172.4, City Code; Ordinance No. 93-45 established the board; Ordinance No. 2005-30 provided that the Leisure Services Director or his/her designee shall serve as secretary to the board and that the board shall meet quarterly.

Reference City Code, Sections 2-75 through 2-77, for provisions that generally apply to all boards. Special requirements relating to this board, not included in Sections 2-75 through 2-77, are noted below.

The board shall assist the City Council and staff in the development and adoption of policies and procedures for operation of the City's golf courses. The board shall also make recommendations relating to the preparation and adoption of the operating and capital budgets for the City's golf courses, including proposals for revenue sources and adjustments in such sources, and operating and capital expenditures.

No recommendations of the board shall be binding on the City Council, staff, or other City boards and committees.

The board shall include seven members. To the greatest extent possible, board members shall include a broad cross-section of the golf players using the City's golf courses. The Leisure Services Director or his/her designee shall serve as secretary of the board.

Four members of the board shall constitute a quorum.

September 13, 2006 – board voted to change the name of the golf courses. August 8, 2007 – board voted to rename Melbourne to Crane Creek Reserve and Harbor City to Mallards Landing. August 28, 2007 – City Council approved renaming Melbourne to Crane Creek Reserve Golf Course at Melbourne and Harbor City to Mallards Landing Golf Course at Melbourne. September 11, 2007 – City Council adopted Resolution No. 2050, providing for the new names.

The board meets the second Wednesday in January, May, September and November, 6:30 p.m., City Council Chamber.
